Provision:

- Additional teaching time and teaching assistant hours.
- Enabling children to access enrichment opportunities such as holiday clubs and after school clubs.
- Supporting funding for residential visits and trips.
- Developing Assessment for Learning strategies to improve engagement in learning.
- Providing a range of family support activities to improve attendance and engagement in learning, including homework.
- Provide focussed strategies for effective learning for targetted children.
- Provide specific Reading and Writing resources.
- Continue training our staff through national projects with a proven impact on the progress and attainment of children.
- Provide reading and writing resources for children to take home and keep.
- Participation in Educational Endowment Fund REACH Project to develop strategies for KS2 Reading.
- Provide support for Mental Health & Wellbeing.
- Providing a Breakfast Club to ensure pupils are ready to learn, while also developing their independence.
- Providing a Homework Club to offer a quiet space to complete homework during the lunch break.
