Snack

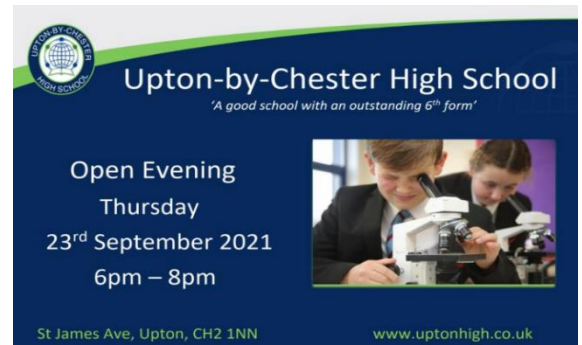
Please, where at all possible, could children bring the correct change if they are buying a snack from the kitchen.

If your child needs to walk home by themselves (Year 5/6) or requires a mobile phone to be brought to school (Year 6), please bring back the completed form.

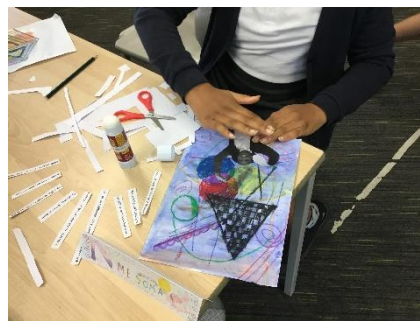
