Where there is COVID within the family, although your child/ren can attend, we would advise you to arrange for your child/ren to have a PCR test as soon as possible and to monitor your child closely for symptoms of COVID-19.

The main symptoms of COVID-19 are the recent onset of:

- new continuous cough and/or
- high temperature and/or
- a loss of, or change in, normal sense of taste or smell (anosmia)

Testing can be arranged by calling 119 or via the NHS website: <u>www.nhs.uk/coronavirus</u>. Please keep us informed of the result of the test.


If your child remains well and symptom-free they should continue to attend school as normal, including while awaiting their PCR test result.

<u> Pupil Premium</u>



Children of families in receipt of certain benefits may be eligible for additional funding – the Pupil Premium Grant (PPG), which we can use to provide free lunches for your child and support in other ways. Even if you don't wish to take advantage of any of this, Chester Blue Coat can still claim much-needed funding for those who are eligible. Under current rules, the funding lasts for 6 years, even if your circumstances change in that time.
