

Terminology that we use in phonics teaching

- **Phoneme**- sound
- **Grapheme** – letter
- **Digraph** – 2 letters, 1 sound
- **Trigraph**- 3 letters, 1 sound
- **Split digraph** – a digraph that is split by a letter
- **Vowels** – a e i o u- These can make a long or short sound.
- **Consonant** –the letters of the alphabet that are not vowels.
- **CVC** – consonant vowel consonant e.g. cat
- **CVCC** –e.g. best
- **CCVC**- e.g. clap
